

The Phelps Mill Festival will be held on July 9 and 10, at Phelps Mill Park, near Underwood, MN. The Festival hosts 150 fine arts and crafters that come from all over the United States to sell their unique and exceptional wares to visitors of the show. Aside from the exhibitors, Phelps Mill Festival hosts thirteen different food booths vended by non-profit groups in the Otter Tail County area. Come and enjoy foods ranging from cotton candy and snocones, to pork chops, and even breakfast on both mornings. In order to preserve this wonderful site, the Phelps Mill Country Board has come up with a plan to host the Festival on the tarred areas surrounding the Park. This ensures that the Festival can still happen as planned, but keeps the Park from the damage that may be caused by large amounts of traffic on the grounds.
